



Afterschool at Sanford – Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I sign my student(s) up for afterschool?

A: The afterschool program at Sanford is free and a registration form will be included in the paperwork packet students bring home on the first day of school. This form is where parents/guardians give a child permission to stay at school until 5:30 Monday - Thursday when afterschool is in session. Families also indicate the kind of transportation (bus, walk, or pick-up) the child will be using.

Q: How does my student know what afterschool classes they'll be in?

A: Students can participate one day a week, two days, three days or all four. Specific activity choices, including which days of the week they stay, are made by students themselves during advisory class the week prior to the start of a session. Fall session begins September 25th and runs through to winter break. We will have around 50 activities/classes offered weekly but the details of those won't be firmed up until mid September. We work hard to make sure all students can participate in their first choice.

Q: When can we find out what afterschool classes are being offered?

A: The full list of fall session afterschool classes will be available the week of September 18, 2017. An email communication will go out to all families with the attachment and a few reminders, but the list will be posted on the Community Education website (where you found this document!) as well. For an EXAMPLE of recent classes please see the next page. No guarantees can be made that the same classes will be offered, but we are working to provide a similar variety of physical, creative, academic, and social options.

Q: My student wants to be in the Project SUCCESS Musical, can they still do other afterschool classes as well?

A: The fall musical cast includes 80-100 students and more than half of those students also participate in additional afterschool classes. Many of our classes operate on a week-to-week drop-in basis so it is no trouble for students to have inconsistent attendance due to their rehearsal schedule. For students who are not in lead roles, the Project SUCCESS rehearsal schedule is typically the same two days each week and those students join afterschool classes on their off days.

Please note: This is an EXAMPLE 😊 There are no guarantees for the same classes to be offered this fall.
