5 Things to Know About After School Activities at Folwell

5 cosas que debe saber sobre las actividades después de la escuela en Folwell

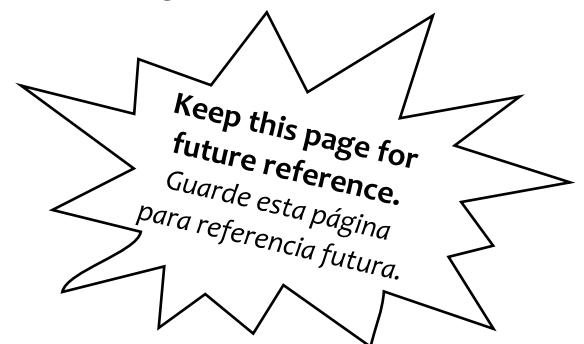
1. **Activities fill up quickly!** Your child may not get his/her first choice activity. If your child receives no activities, s/he will be put on a waiting list and offered a place in the class as space becomes available. // **Las actividades se llenan rápidamente**, así que puede ser que su niño no obtenga su primera elección(es). Si sus niños no tienen actividades, ellos estarán en una lista de espera y serán incorporados al programa lo más antes posible.
2. **We will send home a confirmation letter when your child is officially enrolled in activities. Do not** send your child to activities unless s/he has received a confirmation and/or After School pass. It may take several days before your child can begin. // **Por favor, no envíe a su niño a las actividades antes de recibir una carta de confirmación** y/o un pase para después de la escuela. 3. **Registration forms MUST be filled out completely and signed.** Forms with missing information or signatures may not be accepted. **Turn in forms on or before Friday, September 8th.** Students can give them to their homeroom teacher or to the main office. // Formularios incompletos no se aceptarán. **Entregue formularios antes del viernes 8 de septiembre** o al maestro/a de su estudiante o a la oficina principal.
4. **Good behavior is expected at all times.** Students not following the After School behavior rules may be suspended or removed from activities. Medical and Special Needs // Necesidades Médicas y Especiales

School Health Services are not available during after school. Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying the after school site coordinator for any special needs or medical conditions that impact their child's health, well-being, or involvement in activities. **If your child may need to receive either prescribed or over-the counter medications while attending after school programming, you must complete an authorization form before medication can be dispensed. Minneapolis Community Education Youth Enrichment Program Policies *Política del Programa Juvenil de Educación Comunitaria de Minneapolis*

Student Behavior // Comportamiento de los Estudiantes

In order to promote a safe and engaging environment, Community Education (CE) Youth Enrichment, a program of Minneapolis Public Schools, conforms to the established behavior policies of the school site and the Minneapolis Public Schools Behavior Standards & Code of Conduct (P5200). If an incident does occur, CE staff will notify and work with families to develop reasonable next steps for the safety of all students and staff. This may include suspension or removal from the program without a refund. If a student is suspended from the school day it is also a suspension from CE Youth Enrichment. // *Con el fin de promover un ambiente seguro y de participación, Minneapolis Community Education, un programa de Minneapolis Public Schools, se ajusta a las políticas de comportamiento establecidas por la escuela y a los Estándares de Comportamiento y Código de Conducta (P5200) de Minneapolis Public Schools. 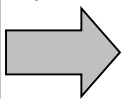
Walking Field Trips // Excursiones Caminando
