Class Descriptions:

Monday (8 Weeks)

Snapology: Epic Minecraft Adventure (Grades 3-4) \$105

EPIC Minecraft® will introduce students to exciting, more complicated aspects of Minecraft including turning yourself into a Minecraft® character, solving common game problems, architecture and exploration in the Minecraft® world in the game and using real world materials.

Mad Science: Techno-Connections (Grades 1-4) \$113

Join Mad Science as we connect with technology. Experience the basic forces that make technology possible: use Newton's laws to make things move, convert potential energy into kinetic energy, leverage simple machines to do your work, and use gravity to keep your balance. Explore the world of future technology as you set up a cellular tower relay to track your friends; program and command real robots, construct a taco battery, and make light from a liquid. And of course, get a great signature Mad Science take-home every day.

Lego Building with Mr. John (Grades K-2) \$32

Do you love Legos? Join your friends for some hands-on Lego playtime. Each week there will be a new theme for creating interesting and imaginative structures.



Tuesday (9 Weeks)

Hale Service Helpers with Ms. Cindy (Grades 3-4) \$5

Join Cindy Goehring to create a service project that will help our community and develop your leadership skills. Students will choose a topic and create a project where they can become agents of good in our community.

Theater is Fun! (Grades 1-2) \$143 for Winter and Spring Session

Have fun building confidence and musical theater skills.

This is a yearlong class that begins in October and ends in May with our final performance of "Cinderella."

Learn singing and acting fundamentals, working in an ensemble, and developing performance technique. Put your vast imagination to work, while having a blast portraying diverse characters and working creatively together.

Medication must be in its original packaging or prescription bottle. All medication will be stored on-site in a locked cabinet. *Medication is not accessible from the school nurse’s office.*

Minneapolis Community Education After School Program Policies

Please review these policies and discuss them with your child before signing your registration form.

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After School Behavior Policy

All children participating in the after-school program are expected to follow the rules for behavior when in class or on the bus. All students are given three chances. First referral, we will speak to student. Second referral, we will talk to student along with a call to the parent/guardian. Third referral, they will be removed from the program or bus depending on reason for referrals. Depending on the reason for referral, a student may receive two or three strikes on the first referral.

After School Activities Cancellation Policy

In the event of inclement or severe weather, the district will decide whether to cancel after school programs. In the event of cancellations, the Transportation Department notifies schools and schools/program coordinators. ALL schools will be notified of closure by 12 pm (noon) on the day of the event.

We will make every effort to contact you if after school activities are cancelled. Please make sure all your contact information is up to date with our office.

***When after school classes are cancelled your child will be sent home on their regular bus at 2 pm unless other arrangements have been made.**

It is very dangerous for a young child to arrive home unexpectedly and not be able to get into his/her home or be at home without supervision. Please have a plan in place for severe weather or cancellations.
