**Registration Confirmation:**

<b>Pinch, Slab, Coil, Clay with Kidcreate Studio</b>	<b>\$109</b>	<i>Open to grades 1-5</i>
It's time for your young artist to roll up their sleeves, make a mess and play with some clay! The children will use a variety of tools and techniques to make animals, castles, bowls and much more. We will work with a variety of different types of clay throughout the class, including both Model Magic® and air-dry clay. The children will use their fingers to pinch, assemble a slab, and create coils as they learn the basics of working with clay.

<b>STEM-TASTIC Class with Snapology</b>	<b>\$80</b>	<i>Open to grades 2-4</i>

<b>Kendama \$68 (Fee includes a Kendama to take home at the end of the class)</b>		<i>Open to grades 3-5</i>
The Kendama is a Japanese toy. Kendama is made up of the "Ken" (handle) and the "Tama" (ball), which is connected by a string. The Kendama tricks are done by variations of juggling the ball in the 3 cups, spiking the ball with the Ken spike, and balancing both in new creative ways. Mastering the Kendama takes practice, focus, patience, and creativity.		
<b>Glee Club</b>	<b>\$70</b>	<i>Open to grades 3-5</i>
Do you like to sing? <b>Kenny's music teacher Ms. Totzke</b> is looking for students who love to sing. Join us as we create a sound all of our own. We will explore musicals, popular songs and create our own unique version of the classics.		
<b>Improv Theater</b>	<b>\$60</b>	<i>Open to grades 1-5</i>
Use improvisational games and activities to hone your voice, body, and imagination. We will create skits, dance, and improvise characters. Together we'll build the confidence necessary for performing live! Led by Mr. Matt.		
<b>Gym Games and Floor Hockey Herb Brooks Rink Rats</b>	<b>\$60</b>	<i>Open to grades 2-5</i>
The Rink Rats program provides opportunities for more students to learn about the great game of hockey. The Herb Brooks Foundation (HBF) aims to teach the fundamentals of hockey through floor hockey and on the ice skating classes. The students start with dryland training in the fall to learn the fundamentals of hockey and teamwork in a floor hockey setting before taking to the ice when outdoor park rinks opened. The students finish the on-ice portion of the program. <b>HBF will supply equipment such as skates, sticks, and helmets.</b>

**Health and Medical**

**School Health Services are not available during Before or After school.** Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying the before/after school site coordinator for any special needs or medical conditions that impact their child’s health, well-being, or involvement in activities. If your child may need to receive either prescribed or over-the counter medications while attending before/after school programming, you must complete an authorization form before medication can be dispensed. **Medication must be in the original packaging or prescription bottle.** All medication will be securely stored on-site.

**Student Behavior**
