Class Descriptions:

Monday

Snapology: Amazing Animals (Grades 2-4) \$105

Build a robotic zoo featuring models with working motors and sensors. Work in teams under guided instructions to build and program Lego models. Build a different model each class. Learning is enhanced through use of laptops.

Chinese with Ms. Nicole (Grades K-4) \$37

Learn something about Mandarin Chinese language and culture. Students will learn some basic Mandarin phrases, and basics on asking and answering questions. Learn about Chinese culture, have fun playing games, learning-and-singing songs in Mandarin, writing Chinese characters, and more.

Knitting with Ms. Deb (Grades 1-4) \$52

Do you want to learn how to knit? If you like to be creative and make things with your hands, you will like this class. Students will do a variety of projects that they can take home and have an opportunity to learn some new skills.

Team Sports with Ms. Kris (Grades K-4) \$37

Lego Building with Mr. John (Grades K-2) \$32

- Herb Brooks Hockey (Grades 1-4) \$50
The Rink Rats program provides opportunities for students to learn about the great game of hockey. The Herb Brooks Foundation (HBF) aims to teach the fundamentals of hockey through floor hockey and on the ice skating classes. The students start with dryland training in the fall to learn the fundamentals of hockey and teamwork in a floor hockey setting before taking to the ice when outdoor park rinks opened. The students finish the on-ice portion of the program.
HBF will supply equipment such as skates, sticks, and helmets.

Minneapolis Community Education After School Program Policies

Please review these policies and discuss them with your child before signing your registration form.

MPS SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES ARE NOT AVAILABLE DURING AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

After school programming is not linked with the school health services office. It does not have access to school records (medical information, health plans, IEPs, Section 504 plans, etc.). Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying the On-site Coordinator of any special needs or medical conditions that impact their child's health, well-being, or involvement in activities. A conference with the family may be requested in order to determine what reasonable accommodations should be provided. If prescribed or over-the-counter medication must be given while a child is attending after school programming, parents/guardians must complete an authorization form before any medicine will be dispensed. Medication must be in its original packaging or prescription bottle. All medication will be stored on-site in a locked cabinet. Medication is not accessible from the school nurse's office.

After School Behavior Policy

All children participating in the after-school program are expected to follow the rules for behavior when in class or on the bus. All students are given three chances. First referral, we will speak to student. Second referral, we will talk to student along with a call to the parent/guardian. Third referral, they will be removed from the program or bus depending on reason for referrals. Depending on the reason for referral, a student may receive two or three strikes on the first referral.

After School Activities Cancellation Policy

In the event of inclement or severe weather, the district will decide whether to cancel after school programs. In the event of cancellations, the Transportation Department notifies schools and schools/program coordinators. ALL schools will be notified of closure by 12 pm (noon) on the day of the event.

We will make every effort to contact you if after school activities are cancelled. Please make sure all your contact information is up to date with our office.

***When after school classes are cancelled your child will be sent home on their regular bus at 2 pm unless other arrangements have been made.**

It is very dangerous for a young child to arrive home unexpectedly and not be able to get into his/her home or be at home without supervision. Please have a plan in place for severe weather or cancellations.
