**Mondays – classes meet 1 day per week**

October 1 – January 14 (13 weeks)

**Karate** **Grades 2 – 5** **\$100 + \$35 for uniform (new students only)**

# Minneapolis Community Education Youth Enrichment Program Policies

## Health and Medical

**School Health Services are not available during Before or After school.** Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying the before/after school site coordinator for any special needs or medical conditions that impact their child's health, well-being, or involvement in activities. If your child may need to receive either prescribed or over-the counter medications while attending before/after school programming, you must complete an authorization form before medication can be dispensed. **Medication must be in the original packaging or prescription bottle.** All medication will be securely stored on-site.

## Student Behavior

In order to promote a safe and engaging environment, Community Education, Youth Enrichment, a program of Minneapolis Public Schools, conforms to the established behavior policies of the school site and the Minneapolis Public Schools Behavior Standards and Code of Conduct (P5200). ## After School Activities Cancellation

In the event of inclement or severe weather, the district will decide whether to cancel after school programs. In the event of cancellations, your child's school will contact families and notice will be posted on [mpls.k12.mn.us](http://mpls.k12.mn.us).
